During the course of my discussion with her, she told me that she is planning to be part of a mission trip to Cameroon, West Africa this year. Amanda lived in Cameroon with her family as missionaries from 1983 to 1991. This year they are celebrating the 25th anniversary of the Leadership Training School. Amanda has been invited to be part of that celebration and to teach some ladies classes and help with a campaign. She needs support for this trip, the total cost will be \$3250. Let me encourage you to pray about this and support her if you can.

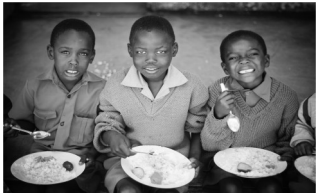

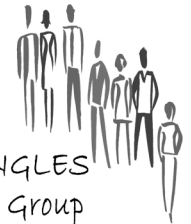
